EVENT INFORMATION

WHAT	The Pacific Office Automation 147 returns to Portland International Raceway for the fourth annual NASCAR Xfinity Series race weekend. The inaugural Pacific Office Automation 147 in 2022 marked the first visit to the Pacific Northwest by a NASCAR national racing series since 2000. In addition to the headliner 75-lap NASCAR Xfinity Series race on Saturday, the 2025 event features the ARCA Menards Series West on Friday and two PRO3 races.
WHEN	August 29 - 30, 2025
WHERE	Portland International Raceway (PIR) in Portland, Ore.
OREGON	This is the only NASCAR national series stop currently in the Pacific Northwest.
TRACK	With its beginning dating to 1960, PIR is a 1.97-mile, 12-turn permanent road course (three left and nine right turns running clockwise) owned and operated by the City of Portland – Parks & Recreation.

RACES SERIES

NASCAR Xfinity Series is a national stock car racing series owned and sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR). The series is one of three national NASCAR series (NASCAR Cup Series and NASCAR CRAFTSMAN Truck Series), and it features races held on short tracks, ovals and road courses. Drivers in the series often include rising stars of the NASCAR Cup Series.

ARCA Menards Series West is a regional stock car racing series operated by the Automobile Racing Club of America (ARCA) and owned and sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR). The races are held on short tracks, ovals and road courses. Drivers in this feeder series use it as a proving ground to move up through the NASCAR ranks.

PRO3 is a spec racing class for BMW E30s in the Pacific Northwest. The series is the largest amateur race class in the International Conference of Sports Car Clubs (ICSCC). Nearly 80 ICSCC licensed drivers will take the wheel of a PRO3, with the average grid size of 20 cars.
